GRANT SUCCESS BOOST FOR ST RUAN REPAIRS

The most pressing repairs to St Ruan Church, which will be well known to those who attend the church, is the floor in the north aisle. The picture on the right shows the state of the joists when the floor boards were lifted which were far damper than anticipated.

The problem has been exacerbated by missing guttering which has caused water ingress resulting in rot to floor joists. Repairs which have already commnced include new guttering with replacement joists and floor boards. We also hope to redecorate the church. We are grateful to the PCC who are funding the replacement of the plastic guttering round the whole building with cast iron.

The cost of the redecoration and floor repairs to be funded by 'the Friends' are approximately £8,000 and we are most grateful to Goonhilly Wind Farm Com-



munity Fund who have awarded £5,000 towards this project. Particularly as further damage was found to the joists when work commenced. Our Midsummer Music event also raised over £500 which was a welcome boost as we fund this important repair.

ST GRADE GATES SORTED!

Following unwelcome visits from cattle it was clear that the gates at St Grade needed replacing! Below you can see the new double gates that were installed last winter. A small repair was also carried out to the single gate pictured right. This project was the first carried out by the Friends and whilst a small start it has made a difference. We now look forward to embarking on some major repairs to this historic church and will keep you
